Questions for Reflection: Mutual Submission

- What stood out to you from these two Scripture passages (Colossians 3:12-19 and Ephesians 5:21-33)? What guestions or insights do they raise for you? What do these passages evoke for you?
- How have you heard these passages interpreted before? What are your responses to the interpretation offered as a part of this series?
- Why do you think the author of Colossians includes this exhortation to wives and husbands directly following exhortations to "clothe ourselves in love"? What were your reactions to hearing this exhortation directly following one of Tabor's 12 Scripture passages (Col. 3:12-17)?
- Why do people choose to get married? What is observed in marriages that discourage some people from entering that kind of relationship?
- What do you think is essential to safeguard a marriage?¹
- What sort of teachings on marriage have you heard from the church? What do you wish the church would say about marriage? Or what are ways you wish that the church would promote and encourage healthy marriages?
- Are there marriages that you have known or seen that provide a positive witness to the love of Christ? What was it about these relationships that stood out to you?
- For those of you who are married, in what ways have you witnessed Christ's love through your relationship? In what ways do you hope to strengthen your marriage to reflect Christ's love for the church?
- What are the characteristics that make for a strong marriage?
