Questions for Reflection: The Church as God's Family

- What stood out to you from the Scripture passages this morning? What struck you? What questions were raised? What new insights did you gain from hearing them in the context of the church as God's Family?
- What do Jesus' words "Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother" mean for you? For Tabor? For the global Church?
- What does it mean to "do the will of God"?
- How does the New Testament imagery of adoption (see Eph. 1:5; Rom. 8:15, 23; Rom. 9:4; Gal. 4:5) speak to you? Are there new insights that this provides for our faith journey?
- How does our experience with our own families (both the baggage and conflicts as well as the acceptance and nurturing we have received) add to or hinder our understanding of the church as family?
- What prevents us from seeing everyone in the pews as our brothers and sisters? What prevents us from seeing those from different denominations as our brothers and sisters? What prevents us from seeing people from different ethnicities and nationalities as our brothers and sisters?
- What do we need to let go of in order to see all who follow Christ as our brothers and sisters?
- What would change if we truly saw the church as our family?
- What are your responses to this series on healthy sexuality? What was meaningful? What raised questions for you? Are there things that you wish would have been addressed that weren't? What have you been pondering throughout this series? What new insights have emerged?
- How has this series impacted your understanding of yourself, the mission of the church, and the culture around us?
