Pastor/Congregational Constructive Feedback Review

There are some important agenda items that the deacons want the congregation to be aware of. At this point, everyone in our congregation should have received a Pastor/Congregational Constructive Feedback form, designed to affirm and strengthen the pastors and the congregation in their ministry. *Extra copies are available on the table in the foyer if you need one.* The deacons encourage you to lift this review up in prayer as you respond to each section.

The deacons ask that you bring the questionnaire to scheduled focus groups on April 22 and April 29 during the faith formation hour. You are encouraged to attend at least one focus group session. If, after attending the first focus session, you find you have more to share, please feel free to attend the second focus group session.

This review process is vital to the health and ministry of our congregation. Jim Stucky, Tabor's Western District Conference Review Consultant, pointed out last Sunday that if you don't participate you may feel like you missed out on something very important to Tabor Church.

Jim Stucky will take the comments made during the focus groups and the questionnaire review, and summarize them to create a final report. Deacons will meet with Jim on Wednesday, May 16, to hear and talk about the results of his summary. Jim will share the final results with the congregation on June 3. The congregational votes of affirmation for the three pastors are scheduled for Sunday, June 17.
