Pastoral Search Committee Congregational Update

The Committee would like to share an update about where we are in the process of finding a new pastor for our congregation!

If you are following our progress checklist on the bulletin board, you will see that we have checked another box! Plans are being made to conduct interviews with pastoral candidates in May. The overarching goal will be to discern whether our congregation and a pastoral candidate have sufficiently common expectations, commitment, values and theologies, etc. Interview questions will focus on the following areas:

- 1. Basic Christian Commitment (basic theology)
- 2. Anabaptist/Mennonite Faith and Commitment (spiritual home with this faith heritage)
- 3. Authority and Interpretation of Scriptures (how does the candidate see and use the Bible?)
- 4. Basic Competence (skills and energy)
- 5. The Person of the Pastor (quality of the person, self esteem, care for others, humility and relationship to God)
- Ministerial Tasks and Roles (how the candidate understands/ embraces the complex functions and roles of the office of ministry)
