This morning we will be reflecting on the practice of lament. Nearly half of all of the psalms include words of lament, reminding us that we can pour out any or all of our emotions before God. Job also poured out his pain before God. Though God's response to Job indicates that there is no guarantee that our questions about suffering will be answered to our satisfaction, God never abandoned Job, just as God never abandons us, even in the midst of suffering and uncertainty. God is faithful, and God hears our cries for help in our suffering.
