Goessel Ministerial Alliance Joint Worship Service: The GMA will offer a joint worship service for the three area churches. This idea was inspired by the joint service that we did last year in celebration of the 150th year marking our forebears' immigration. That service was widely appreciated! We also felt it was time to make a change from the Thanksgiving meal followed closely by the Christmas Brass Concert. We will continue to host the Christmas Brass, but let go of the Community Thanksgiving meal. We feel that it's beneficial for our congregations to worship together at least one time per year!
